

*In Respectful Memory of Jeff Baskin  
To Cover or to Reveal?*

In a short few weeks, just a few days before Rosh HaShanah, the congregation will be hosting a Dedication and Dinner in Memory of Jeff Baskin. I could not agree more that Jeff is deserving of the tribute. He served the congregation faithfully and well for many, many years. He was a gabbai in years when there was a rabbi and de facto spiritual leader in years when there wasn't. He was a teacher to many and a friend to many more. He stood for education and community involvement. It was truly a pleasure to serve alongside him for the years I did.

It is in many ways fitting that the Board of Directors chose to honor Jeff's service and memory with a campaign to purchase new covers for the Holy Ark, the Torah Scrolls and the Bimah. Thank you to all who have and will participate in the project and the upcoming dinner.

Jeff, of blessed memory, now has a broader vantage point than most of us as he metaphorically looks down on this project and I cannot help but wonder what some of his thoughts might be. Of course, I think he would be thrilled that the community is honoring the ritual items he held so dear. But part of me wonders if there might also be caution in his excitement. Many of you knew Jeff longer and better than I did. But I knew him as a man of integrity and content; a man of spiritual enthusiasm and intellectual curiosity. It seems to me he would love that we adorn the Ark and Scrolls and Bimah. But he also might care about how the congregation plans to put the new adornments to use. He might wonder if the newly covered Torahs would be studied with seriousness and respect? Will the Torahs be a showpiece or an object Holy for its form and its content - a content that congregants want to learn, grapple to understand and consider how to apply to their lives? Will people face the newly covered Ark in sincere prayer - humble and heartfelt, be it joyous or tear-filled? Will the money raised from the dinner be spent on educational speakers and projects, on exploring new ways to be spiritually inspired or on ways to integrate into and contribute toward the society around us? Will another person put in the effort to step up as the next religious lay leader - preparing and communicating in advance of the service, scrolling Torahs to the right place for Holy Days, learning as best he can how to lead any or all parts of the service, patiently calling pages or guiding the congregation with or without the partnership of a rabbi? I can imagine that these things are as important to Jeff as the colors or inscriptions on the new covers.

It is now public knowledge that this will be my last year as rabbi of Agudath Achim. While Jeff and I were different in many ways, I am proud to say I think we shared passion for Torah, for Prayer and for Community. I share what I think would be his concerns about the congregation's present apathy toward study, laxness toward attending and participating in prayers and isolation from community engagement. But Jeff was a pretty relaxed, patient fellow and as the saying goes, it is a marathon and not a sprint. How fitting to honor Jeff just days before Rosh HaShanah and Yom Kippur, which are a Divinely gifted opportunity to reflect, evaluate and improve. Whether under my leadership or the memory of Jeff or a new lay-leader or a new rabbi, I pray that the coming Holy Days and months and years will bring renewed understanding, commitment, respect and desire for the core values and practices of Jewish life. May there be not only a ceremony to dedicate new covers, but a re-dedication in our minds and hearts and actions to the values and principles of the items being covered.
