Please note:

- COVID-19 can be more severe in those who are older (70 years of age and over) and those with underlying medical conditions. Please consider this increased risk when considering attending services.
- There will be no Kiddush or socializing before or after the service.
- You may need to wait outside before entering the building. You will need to remain 6 feet apart from others while waiting outside. Please come prepared for the weather.

We ask that you observe the new rules for inside the Synagogue.

- Do not attend if your answers to any of the screening questions change to “Yes” before the service.
- Bring your own mask, tallit and kippah.
- Answer questions from the screener at the door.
- Wear a mask (cloth or medical) completely covering the nose and mouth throughout the service. Valve masks, neck gaiters and bandanas are not sufficient.
- Sit in the seat that has been assigned to you. Your seat assignment will be provided to you when you enter the Synagogue. Please remain in your seat at all times during the service, except if you

must use the bathroom. Please limit use of the bathroom if possible, as it can only be used by one person at a time.

- Children must remain with their parents at their seats during the service.
- Use the alcohol-based hand rub frequently and as directed.
- Do not go near anyone else who is not already your close contact or in your “social bubble”. Stay at least 6 feet apart from anyone who is not your close contact or in your “social bubble”.
- Only sing softly in a speaking voice.
- Leave the synagogue immediately after the service.
- Follow all instructions of the lay leaders, Rabbi and other officials at the synagogue.
- We will share your contact information only with local public health officials if requested by these officials. This would be needed if a person with COVID-19 attended the same service that you attended.
